Rules & Regulations for the “Battle of the Saints Cricket Carnival - 2009”

1. All teams should be present at the St. Peter's College Ground by 8.15 a.m. (Sunday mass will be celebrated at 7.30am) on 6th of December 2009.
2. The last day for registration of teams would be 3rd December 2009.
3. Tournament draw will be held on 4th of December 2009, 6.00 pm at SPC OBU Secretariat – A team representative is expected to be present for the draw.
4. The tournament rules will be briefed after the draw on the 4th of Dec 2009.
5. Teams who are absent for the draw will be grouped by the organizing committee accordingly.
6. We kindly request the teams to be present for the respective match within 5 minutes after the team names are announced. After three announcements the organizing committee will have the right to award a walk over the opponents.
7. Each team should comprise of 6 players and one reserve. Minimum of 4 players should be present to start a game. The Wicket Keeper will not be allowed to bowl.
8. In the case of a tie, the wicket keepers will bowl one over each. Should the game remain tied the winners will be decided by a toss of a coin.
9. All team members in a given team should belong to the same batch (eg: batch of A/L 1999).
10. The maximum number of teams allowed from a batch is two. The teams will be registered on a first come first serve basis.
11. Number of Overs per innings would be 5
12. 4 runs will be awarded for a Wide delivery and 2 runs for a No Ball. No extra ball will be awarded except for the 5th over of each innings.
13. Umpires decision is final. The organizing committee in consultation with the tournament officials will have the right to decide on any matter as and when necessary.
